Subject: Funding to Fox Sports for under-represented sports

Purpose:

To update you on the deliverables Fox Sports has achieved as part of the Under-Represented, Emerging and Niche sports grant and request agreement to pay the next \$7.5 million milestone.

Background to the grant

The Government has committed to provide funding of \$7.5 million per annum (GST exclusive) over four years to Fox Sports to increase the television and online coverage of sports that receive low or no broadcast exposure: women's sports, niche sports, and those sports that command high levels of community involvement and participation.

The first grant payment of \$7.5 million was paid to Fox Sports in February 2018. In September 2018, the Department accepted the 2017-18 Performance Report and the 2018-19 Strategic Roadmap and made the second payment of \$8.25 million (incl. GST) under the funding agreement with Fox Sports. Milestone documentation for the 2018-19 financial year has now been received.

Administration of funding

As part of the funding agreement, Fox Sports is required to meet specific performance targets and milestones. The following reports need to be provided each year:

• the forward work plan (or 'Strategic Roadmap'): under the funding agreement, the Commonwealth (through the Department) is required to agree to a forward work program (a strategic roadmap), which is developed by a governance committee established within Fox Sports to review and assess the sports to be funded by the grant and report on Fox Sport's performance.

Representatives from Media Branch and Fox Sports met on 11 June 2019 to discuss the types of sports that Fox Sports proposed should receive funding during the 2019-20 Financial Year. Fox Sports then submitted the required documents for this milestone payment on time. Officials at Fox Sports sat down with the Department on 14 August 2019 to explain the details in the documents.

At this meeting, the Department requested a more detailed explanation in relation to expenditure across the cost sub-categories. On 23 September 2019, a satisfactory explanation was provided.

2019-20 Strategic Roadmap

The Strategic Roadmap (Attachment B) complies with the requirements set out in the funding agreement. The Roadmap outlines the allocation of funds from the Government's Underrepresented Sports Grant by code, competition, hours and spend for FY20.

Thirteen different sport codes will benefit including; AFL, Football (Soccer), Rugby Union, Rugby League, Cycling, Lawn Bowls, Life Saving, Cricket, Basketball, Gymnastics, Hockey, Baseball and Softball. Funding is to be allocated to 29 women's sport competitions, 23 niche sport competitions and 13 emerging sport competitions.

Fox Sports will broadcast at least 1580 hours of live coverage and more than 4600 hours in total of women, niche and emerging sports. Fox Sports forecasts an increase in coverage from 2016-17 s47G

Fox Sports - operational context

Fox Sports is wholly owned by Foxtel. Foxtel offers licenced subscription television services to Australians. Foxtel currently has 360 subscription broadcasting licences for its diverse range of radio and television channels. In addition to sport, Foxtel broadcasts entertainment (fiction and

non-fiction), news and current affairs programming. Its service is supported by a combination of advertising and subscription revenue.



Conclusion


Fox Sports has demonstrated robust governance, and appear committed to maximising the full potential of the grant with a forward work plan that targets underrepresented and niche sports.


Executive Summary

- The Strategic Roadmap outlines the allocation of funds from the Government's Under-represented Sports Grant by code, competition, hours and spend for FY20.
- Thirteen different sport codes will benefit including; AFL, Football (Soccer), Rugby Union, Rugby League, Cycling, Lawn Bowls, Life Saving, Cricket, Basketball, Gymnastics, Hockey, Baseball and Softball.
- Funding is to be allocated to 29 women's sport competitions, 23 niche sport competitions and 13 emerging sport competitions.
- FOX SPORTS anticipates to broadcast at least 1580 hours of live coverage and more than 4600 hours in total of women, niche and emerging sports.
- FOX SPORTS anticipates an increase in coverage from 2016-17.
- The costs incurred by FOX SPORTS for the acquisition and broadcast of women's, niche and emerging sports in 2019-20 will exceed the \$7.5m grant allocation.
- This 2019-20 Strategic Roadmap is not exhaustive some partial expenses have been omitted, and not all women's, niche or emerging sport competitions broadcast on FOX SPORTS are listed.







AFL Women's (AFLW) is Australia's national Australian rules football league for female players. The first season of the league began in February 2017 with eight teams and 29 matches. In 2020 there will be 14 teams in the competition.

BROADCAST COVERAGE:

Previous level of broadcast coverage:

2017 was the first year of the AFLW competition and it was broadcast on FOX SPORTS and the Seven Network.

FOX SPORTS will produce coverage of approximately 21 matches and will broadcast all matches throughout the season. There will be an increase from approximately 50 live hours in 2016/2017 to over 750 hours of live and delayed coverage in 2019/20.

- FOX SPORTS will produce coverage of approximately 17 matches for broadcast transmission.

DESCRIPTION:

FFA Cup is an annual national football knockout competition consisting of 32 teams from both the top division and lower tiers. This includes the 10 A-League teams and remaining 22 teams composed of semi-professional and amateur qualifiers.

BROADCAST COVERAGE:

Previous level of broadcast coverage:

FOX SPORTS has broadcast limited coverage of the FFA Cup since its inception in 2014¹.

Is this an increase/enhancement on 2016/17?

✓ Yes

If yes, what is the extent of the increase/enhancement?

FOX SPORTS will produce coverage of approximately 31 matches which will be either broadcast or streamed. There will be an increase from approximately 22 live hours in 2016/2017 to over 160 hours of live and delayed coverage in 2019/20.

Will the coverage span multiple years?

FOX SPORTS intends to support the FFA Cup for the duration of the grant.

RATIONALE FOR SELECTION OF SPORT/COMPETITION:

- ✓ FFA Cup is Australia's only true nationwide knockout competition involving grassroots teams and offers pathways for aspiring athletes by providing an opportunity for every member federation to compete.
- ✓ Football has a large participation base with over 1.3m domestic participants. A record 701 teams participated in the 2016 edition of the FFA Cup.
- ✓ The FFA Cup offers a unique opportunity to connect the grassroots to the professional league, allowing the FFA to drive strong levels of community engagement and participation.





2. Impact of COVID-19

In many COVID-19 began impacting sports captured under the Grant in March 2020. The consequences have been significant, and include the cases full recovery will take several years.

- The uncertainty surrounding the postponement of the Olympic Games has added extra challenges for many of our Grant partners as they attempt to modify their event schedules, qualifying campaigns and athlete protocols, whilst managing significant disruptions to their commercial and funding models.
- From discussions with our partners we expect some competitions to be cancelled in their entirety, others to have reduced events available for broadcast and many to have modified and shortened seasons. Despite the potential for reduced content, in many circumstances our partners will require an increased funding commitment from FOX SPORTS as their other major sources of revenue such as sponsorship nave been greatly diminished.
- The Grant partners would most benefit from the following measures:
- Financial certainty to be provided upfront to assist in planning for 2020/21;
- Flexibility in the broadcast hours KPI's to match the uncertainty of their forward looking schedules;
- Commitment from Fox Sports to extend their support into 2021/22 where possible.


