Shire of CI community welcome event for new Administrator

22 July 2023

Hi everyone, it's wonderful to join you here together tonight.

Air services to support the IOT



The Australian Government is supporting the upcoming Territory Week events on Christmas Island with additional air services.

I have been in discussions with the Department and Virgin Australia about the increased demand for flights during the celebrations and coinciding school holiday period and Virgin has now confirmed two additional services to and from Christmas Island, operating on 1 and 8 October 2023.

A week-long event in early October, Territory Week celebrates the culture of Christmas Island and commemorates it becoming an Australian territory in 1958.

Unfortunately, full circuit flights also servicing the Cocos (Keeling) Islands were requested but were unable to be scheduled due to operational requirements. However, it is important to remember that additional flights servicing Christmas Island reduce pressure and demand on the regular full circuit flights, which include flights to Cocos.

My office continues to have regular engagement with Virgin Australia on air services to the IOT, and is aware of recent issues affecting mail on the Cocos (Keeling) Islands and baggage offloads. I will continue to advocate and engineer solutions moving forward with Virgin Australia and the Department including providing feedback from the local communities.

Great progress with Drumsite Water Main Replacement project



The majority of the works to replace a 3.7km section of the Summit to Drumsite water main are already completed.

There's now 3.4km of the new pipe in the ground, located alongside Murray Road in the CI National Park.

Service location is complete and digging for the final stretch along Murray Road is under way. Next steps in the project will include pressure testing and preparation for connection to the scheme

The works to replace the water main commenced late May, starting from the Summit tank in the National Park and progressing towards the Drumsite tank. At this stage, works remain on track to be complete by October this year.

The water main replacement project is funded by the Australian Government, through Water Corporation, with the project supporting a more secure water supply for Christmas Island into the future.



Thank you for attending the PATS community information sessions

Thank you to all who attended the recent community sessions, or provided written feedback, on the Indian Ocean Territories Health Service Patient Assisted Travel Scheme (PATS).

The Scheme assists eligible IOT residents to access health-related specialist and acute care services on the mainland. The scheme provides a financial subsidy to cover a portion of the 'out of pocket' expenses incurred when eligible residents need to travel off island to access specialist services.

The sessions took place on West and Home Island, as well as Christmas Island throughout July. They provided a forum for community members to give their feedback on the scheme and the way it operates, to the IOTHS and IOTHS Community Advisory Committee.

Patient assisted travel schemes are an important means to provide equitable access to health services for people living in remote communities, such as the Indian Ocean Territories, and it is important to make

sure that the scheme will best meet the needs of the community going forward.

The IOTHS is now considering all feedback received and reviewing the PATS policy and guidelines. This will include updating it where relevant in line with similar schemes in other jurisdictions.

Helping IOT pensioners and students to stay connected

The Australian Government runs travel schemes for residents of Christmas Island and the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, to help pensioners and students with travel to and from the mainland.

The IOT Pensioner Annual Free Trip Scheme provides eligible pensioners in the IOT with access to Australian mainland services not available in remote areas. Pensioners who are permanent residents of CI or CKI, who have a Pensioner Concession Card (PCC) issued by Centrelink are entitled to receive one free return airfare to Perth per calendar year.

Under the IOT Student Subsidised Travel Scheme, secondary students and tertiary students not receiving any type of Centrelink Youth Allowance who meeting eligibility requirements can receive assistance to travel to attend their full-time studies.

Both schemes aim to provide a comparable level of assistance to that received by students and pensioners in remote areas of WA and are operated along similar guidelines to the WA Government schemes.

Information on eligibility, guidelines for the scheme and how to apply are available here ([Travel Schemes | Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts](#)) on the Department's website.

Eligible residents need to ensure applications are submitted at least one month prior to the first intended date of travel to allow for the timely processing of applications. Applications must be mailed or e-mailed to the Travel Assistance Officer at the Department's Perth office.

Skateboarding visit to Christmas Island no wipeout



The four-day visit to Christmas Island of Jack Dowden from [Build Up Skateboarding](#) in late June was a massive success – with some 200 participants

attending the three workshops held at the Shire Skatepark and School.

Over the course of the visit, the Christmas Island Skateboard Program brought together young skateboarders from across the community, to develop new skills and grow their capabilities – while building a sense of camaraderie and community among the attendees.

Along with developing their coordination, balance, and motor skills throughout the workshops, the participants were provided an outlet for self-confidence and personal growth –and were empowered to set goals, take risks and celebrate their achievements.

The visit of the Build Up Skateboarding team to Christmas Island was funded by the Australian Government, through the WA Department of Local Government, Sport and Cultural Industries.

ABC Heywire competition open

The annual ABC Heywire competition is now open where young people living in Australia's regional, rural and remote communities are encouraged to tell the nation what life is like in their part of the world.

Located 2,600 kilometres from the Australian mainland, life for young people in the Indian Ocean Territories (IOT) is vastly different to most young Australians, with the Heywire Competition providing a national platform to tell their stories.

In the past three years, two IOT residents have won the national competition – Rania from Home Island who won in 2021, whose inspiring story of living with osteogenesis imperfecta showcases the capacity of the human spirit to overcome even the greatest challenges, and Alissa from Christmas Island whose story of studying her Bachelor of Islamic Studies to support other young people on Christmas Island to be able to talk to someone their age about their faith won the competition in 2022.

If you are aged between 16-22 years living on Christmas Island or the Cocos (Keeling) Islands, you can submit your story to Heywire and, if selected as a winner, have an opportunity to work with ABC producers to have your story featured across ABC platforms including ABC TV, Radio National, local radio, Triple J and ABC iview.

As a winner, you could also have the opportunity to attend the annual Heywire Regional Youth Innovation Summit, where, along with up to 39 other winners, you will be able to connect with other young people to explore issues, challenge ideas and look at ways to make a positive impact in your community.

The winners will be announced in early 2024, with submissions closing Friday 1 September 2023.

SKIN CHECK CLINICS

The Health Service is aware the community on Christmas Island would like access to skin clinics. To meet this need, the Health Service will offer 30-minute skin check appointments on Wednesdays between 3pm – 7pm.

These appointments will be for skin checks only and will not be for other medical issues (e.g. prescriptions). If these appointments are clogged with other requests,

it undermines the reason for dedicating the hours to provide skin checks.

Dr Deidre McAlpine has advanced training in Skin Cancer Medicine through the University of Queensland, holding the following qualifications:

- Certificate in Skin Cancer Therapeutic
- Certificate in Primary Care Skin Surgery
- Advanced Certificate in Dermoscopy
- Advanced Certificate in Skin Surgery/Head, Neck, Lower Back
- Advanced Certificate in General Dermatology.

Dr Hafiz also did his training through the University of Queensland and completed:

- Professional Certificate of Skin Cancer Surgery
- Advanced Certificate of Skin Cancer Medicine.

Any suspicious lesions will NOT be excised at the time of skin check appointment because this needs to be planned with nurse assistance available, but an appointment for removal will be booked during the check if needed.

The clinics will be a trial to assess/evaluate demand and ongoing need. Clinics are set to start on 13 September, so please contact the Health Service to make an appointment.

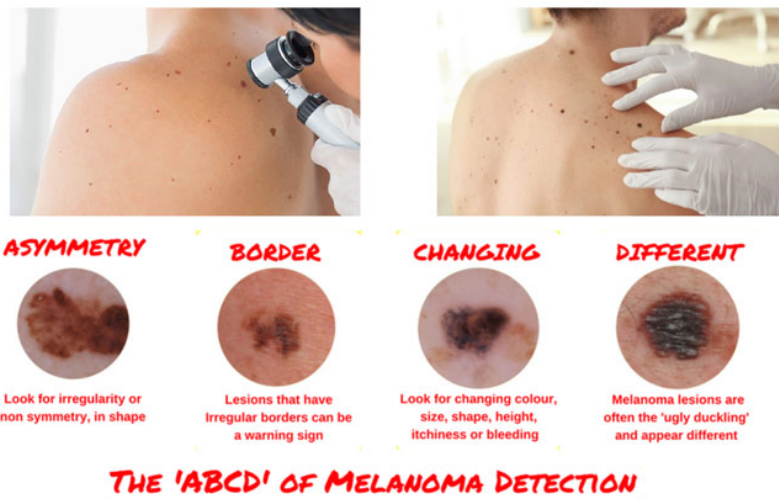

Deidre McAlpine医生在昆士兰大学接受过皮肤癌医疗专门培训，拥有以下资格证书：

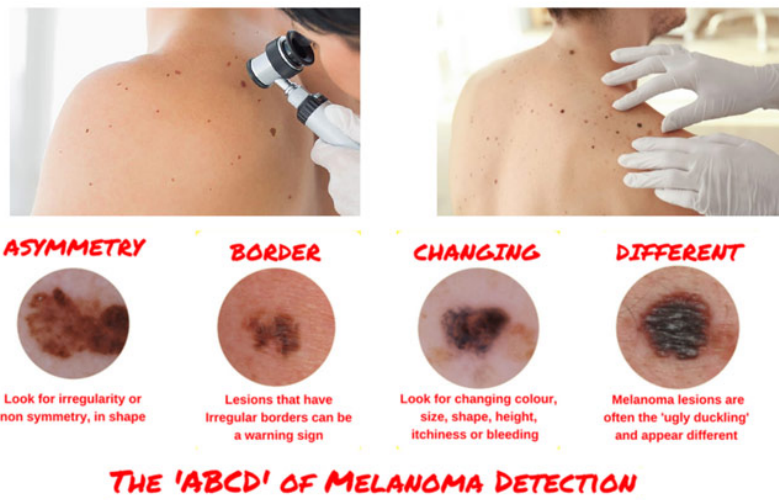

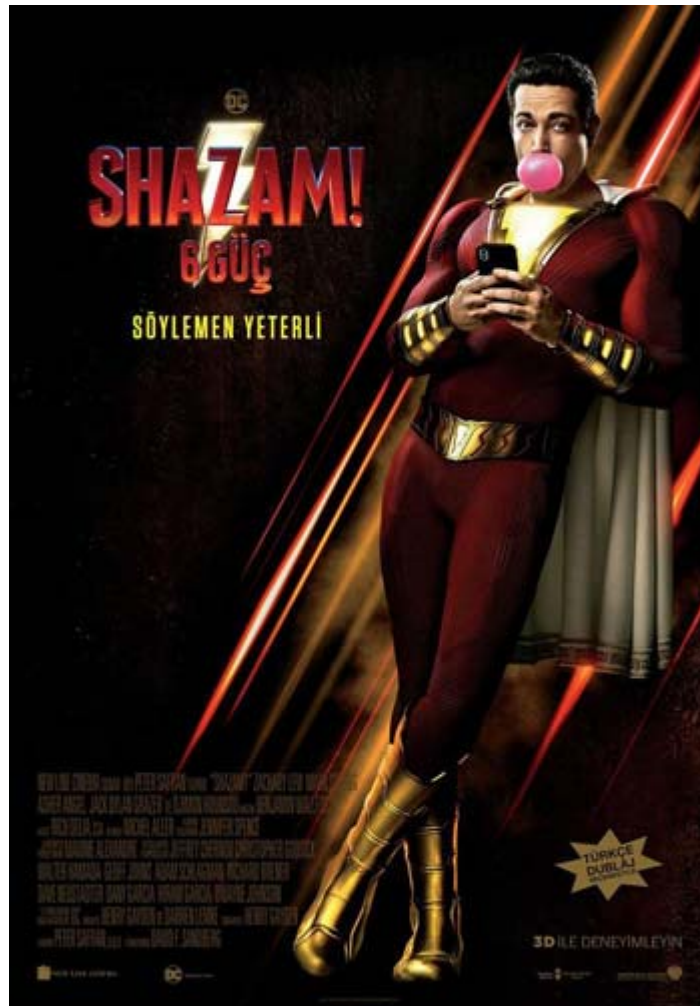
