



We should follow the lead of Federal Judge Terry Doughty of the Western District of Louisiana who recently issued a preliminary injunction barring the White House and several federal agencies from trying to get social media companies from censoring people or posts.

On page 102 of the memorandum, Judge Doughty neatly explained the stakes.

“Without a free debate about these issues, each person is unable to decide for himself or herself the proper decision regarding their health. Each United States citizen has the right to decide for himself or herself what is true and what is false. The Government... does not have the right to determine the truth.”

This is absolutely the approach a democratic society should take with regard to governmental involvement and free speech.

Combating mis/dis information should be in an open debate, and the government should NOT be the arbiter of peoples opinions.
