How can Australian Government be members of the WEF? (World Economic Forum).

Based upon Australian Constitution

Chapter 1 Point 44

44. Disqualification

Any person who:

(i) is under any acknowledgement of allegiance, obedience, or adherence to a foreign power, or is a subject or a citizen or entitled to the rights or privileges of a subject or a citizen of a foreign power; or...

I take this to mean, WEF members are ineligible to be in parliament and should be disqualified.

The WHO (World Health Organisation) is a foreign United Nations organisation. IF Australian governmental bodies are ACTING upon WHO information, whether or not WHO is categorised as a Foreign Power is irrelevant BECAUSE Australian governmental bodies are ACTING upon WHO information. Therefore they are a De-Facto foreign power.

Part V – Powers of the Parliament

51. Legislative powers of the Parliament

The Parliament shall, subject to this Constitution, have power to make laws for the peace, order, and good government of the Commonwealth with respect to:

The Parliament has NOT been able to effect peace, order and good government. This is apparent by the largest demonstration in Canberra 2022.

The only reason the government is trying to implement this legislation is to hide failings in the governance of the following constitutional responsibilities of almost every point of the Australian Constitution.
