CRIMES ACT 1958 - SECT 195E

Concealing conduct, agreement or arrangement

- (1) A person must not <u>encourage</u> another person to conceal from a <u>relevant authority conduct</u>, or an agreement or arrangement in respect of conduct, that corrupts or would corrupt a betting outcome of an event or event contingency—
- (a) knowing that, or being reckless as to whether, the <u>conduct</u> corrupts or would corrupt a betting outcome of the <u>event</u> or <u>event</u> contingency; and
- (b) intending to obtain a financial advantage, or cause a financial disadvantage, in connection with any betting on the event or event contingency.

Penalty: level 5 imprisonment (10 years maximum).

Concealing offences for benefit

S. 326(1) (1) Where a person has committed a serious indictable offence, any other person who, knowing or believing that the offence,
