A guide to the applicability of the Australian Design Rules (ADRs) in force for M – Category Vehicles – Passenger Vehicles

1. The table is for guidance only. Users must refer to the relevant standard for the circumstances under which the standard is mandatory or optional.
  
2. The Table shows the national road vehicle standards (Australian Design Rules, listed as **ADR No.**) currently in force for new model vehicles and the vehicle categories to which they are applicable, as at the date this Applicability Summary is published (see footer ). This table provides a quick overview to:
  - a. the **Date** on which each of the national road vehicle standards have or will come into force and the **Vehicle Categories** to which they will be applicable. New standards yet to commence are highlighted light green;
  - b. applicable earlier revisions of the national standards that may be accepted as equivalent to the standards in force for new model vehicles (refer to each relevant standard’s list of acceptable prior rules); and
  - c. the national road vehicle standards that have been superseded by other standards with a different number series (light yellow highlighted) or withdrawn with no direct replacement (light red highlighted).
  
3. Australian Design Rule (ADR) notation:
  - a. ADR X/00 indicates the original version of ADR X.
  - b. ADR X/01 indicates the first revised version of a standard where the amendment increases in stringency, includes additional vehicle categories, or changes content significantly. ADR X/02 is the second revision, and so on.
  - c. ADR X/..., the ellipsis ... indicates the applicable version(s) of the ADR in force at the time.
  
4. Vehicle Category Codes:
  - a. Codes for vehicle categories and definitions are in **ADR Definitions and Vehicle Categories** and the ADR can be viewed here - [Federal Register of Legislation - Vehicle Standard \(Australian Design Rule – Definitions and Vehicle Categories\) 2005](#).
  - b. **MA - PASSENGER CAR** - A passenger vehicle, not being an off-road passenger vehicle or a forward- control passenger vehicle, having up to 9 seating positions, including that of the driver.
  - c. **MB - FORWARD-CONTROL PASSENGER VEHICLE** - A passenger vehicle, not being an off-road passenger vehicle, having up to 9 seating positions, including that of the driver, and in which the centre of the steering wheel is in the forward quarter of the vehicle’s ‘Total Length’.
  - d. **MC - OFF-ROAD PASSENGER VEHICLE** - A passenger vehicle having up to 9 seating positions, including that of the driver and being designed with special features for off-road operation. See **Definitions and Vehicle Categories** for special features.
  - e. **MD - LIGHT OMNIBUS** - An omnibus with a ‘Gross Vehicle Mass’ not exceeding 5.0 tonnes.
  - f. **ME - HEAVY OMNIBUS** - An omnibus with a ‘Gross Vehicle Mass’ exceeding 5.0 tonnes.
  - g. The United Nations (UN) Vehicle Category Codes are also shown in brackets below the ADR category.
