I have a metallic prosthetic limb that will ALWAYS trigger an alarm during screening. We personalise the check-in and boarding and seating for travel - why not optionally/selectively personalise the security screening? I am happy to go through an independent security process (like a police check) that would give some reassurance that I'm "clean", in return for a more humane treatment at security.. I am thoroughly sick of having to get half undressed - have you tried refitting a watch and belt one-handed? Air crew show their ASICs and go through an express lane. Perhaps people with a disability (or other legitimate need) could apply for an Air Travel Security Card that allowed them to transit security via a dedicated lane, where we were physically checked with a wand, rather than suffering the indignity of removing clothing pointlessly, and being sent through the scanner pointlessly a second time, Alternatively broaden the eligibility for an AVID. Then put in place differential security checking for aviation card holders.
