So where do I begin, I have approached the Australian government , defence , Arena , and every other government organisation about this Bio fuel non edible oil crop in Darwin NT , and absolutely no takers or even any help to get this energy crop in the ground. If you had taken more notice 5 years ago you would have your first production by now. Calophyllum inophyllum or the Beauty Leaf tree is the best per hectare source of any feedstock oil any where in the world because it can produce around 10,000 litres per hectare , crops twice per year ,

is relatively easy to mass replicate for mass plantings,

Is drought tolerant,

has no major pests and diseases,

Produces, honey, Biochar and a whole host of other value streams.

If you planted 100,000 hectares of Calophyllum that will give you around 900 million litres of SAF every year for the next 150 years as this tree can live for 500 years.

Due to the inaction of the NT and Australian Governments this tree will now be developed my the Japanese on NT soil and the oil will go to Japan to be turned into SAF to be sold back to Australia.

Do you see the madness in that.

Anyway that's what I think of your green aviation paper. You have no interest in supporting Australian new agribusiness and it's a shame because it would of been a great opportunity for Australia to be a power house in feedstock oil for SAF
