passenger jet aircraft flying at 30 to 40000 ft overhead continually. At my last meeting with	
Air Services we discussed a r	ange of approach flight paths. all of which would be of little
relief to the continuous noise. I was astonished that there is a flight path that would give us	
some great relief but because	it would cost a little increase in fuel cost it was not generally
used.	

Brisbane Airport is far from working capacity so we are facing further increases of life impacting noise with no relief

The Minister has been approached and showed no interest (period) in the only solution which is to introduce a cap and curfew, so we are condemned with continued and increasing noise, which is a shameful situation
