Short comment

As a company we endorse what seem practical measures to allocate priority based on risk based criteria. We would comment that using departure point by region misses the point, which is that fatigue and fuel state are more critical for ultra long-range flights. Consideration could be given to using a flight time trigger (I would suggest 14 hours but that could be open to further discussion but needs to clearly distinguish between ULR and other flights), this information is easily available to ATC vis the FPL.
