# Conditions for single road vehicle applications with multiple identical vehicles

October 2023

You can apply for multiple identical vehicles – up to 30 identical vehicles (or 4 identical trailers) in one single road vehicle application. It saves time and money because you only need to complete one application and pay one application fee. However, a Register of Approved Vehicle (RAV) entry fee must be paid for each vehicle.

The table below shows which single road vehicle applications can include multiple identical vehicles and provides information on application conditions.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>Any vehicle type</li><li>RAV entry or MVSA plate</li><li>Will be subject to SSM</li></ul>	New	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>All vehicles in the application must be identical in every aspect, except for the VIN.</li></ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Special purpose vehicle</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>If the make and model of the special purpose vehicles in the application are identical, the assessment will cover them all.</li> <li>All compliance information submitted must be relevant to every vehicle on the application.</li> <li>You can add a different build date for each vehicle if the date range does not change ADR applicability for the vehicle category.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Moped or motorcycle not on the RAV/no MVSA plate</li> <li>Used 2 and 3 wheeled vehicles that will be modified by a RAW</li> </ul>	Used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Where the make, model and build date are the same, a single assessment can be completed against Specialist and Enthusiast Vehicle entry and Model Report.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Trailers</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Up to 4 identical vehicles can be included in an application.</li> <li>All trailers in the application must be identical in every aspect, except for the VIN and build date.</li> <li>The build date is the date the trailer manufacture was substantially finished.</li> <li>The applicability date for Australian Design Rules is the application date.</li> </ul>
<b>Non-RAV import approval</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Race or rally vehicles</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>All vehicles in the application must be identical in every aspect, except for the VIN.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Public exhibition vehicles</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make and model must be the same.</li> <li>All vehicles must be covered by the supporting information.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Vehicles to be used in film or video</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make and model must be the same.</li> <li>All vehicles must be equally covered by the supporting information.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Testing or market evaluation vehicles</li> </ul>	New and used	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make and model must be the same.</li> <li>Test plan must covers all vehicles.</li> </ul>
