A National Registry With independent assessment for Assistance Animals (like the GHAD) would create higher standards of trained dogs. This registration card can be used for accessing public transport - and would create safer access due to higher standards of trained dogs. Currently it seems anyone can slap a vest on any dog and call it an assistance dog, with little training and zero independent assessment, nor any tasks. There are few dogs trained to meet a higher standard and deemed safe in public. A National Registry (like the GHAD) is the solution.
