**2022 Review of the Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002**

Thank you for the opportunity to provide a submission to the 2022 Review of the Disability Standards for Accessible Public Transport 2002.

The City of Sydney (the City) has a long history of providing quality public transport infrastructure, as well as facilitating key outcomes for enhanced public transport in our community. This includes recently providing over 330 new accessible bus stops, and working collaboratively with Transport for NSW (TfNSW) to deliver public transport infrastructure upgrades, such as the CBD and South East Light Rail.

We welcome this Review and look forward to recommendations which will support the provision of accessible and inclusive public transport for our residents and workers, and which will reduce barriers to social, cultural and economic participation for people with disability.
