Some railway platforms in Brisbane are too narrow and do not allow enough space for ramps to fit and thus wheelchairs to exit trains. Trains often do not pull up in the right spot and the ramp doesn't fit. Platform 1 at Eagle Junction in Brisbane is a classic case. At South Brisbane there are posts along the platform and if the train does not pull up in the right spot for wheelchair exit then the post makes it impossible for a wheelchair to exit the train.
