I am writing to you regarding the Community Development Grants (CDG) program commitments made by the former Australian Government. Your organisation has been identified as having a commitment made under this program which is not yet contracted.

The Australian Government has decided to close the CDG program in line with the broader redesign of regional grant programs announced today. The Government has retained sufficient funds to honour any uncontracted CDG commitments provided that projects are contracted within six months and can be fully delivered by 30 June 2026.

I am pleased to advise that the Department of Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development, Communications and the Arts (the Department) has been tasked with assessing your project and finalising an executed funding agreement within the next six months.

Please note, if you are unable to execute a funding agreement by 28 April 2023, or if your project cannot be completed by 30 June 2026, this commitment will be withdrawn. If relevant, you will be notified of this withdrawal in writing.

We look forward to working with you to deliver your project for the benefit of your local community. To enable us to progress the assessment of your project, we will be contacting you by telephone and/or email to discuss the next steps in your assessment process, in the coming weeks.

In the meantime, I strongly recommend your organisation does not enter into financial commitments or begin construction work on your project until you execute a funding agreement with the Department, as any expenditure incurred prior to executing an agreement may not be eligible for reimbursement.

In approving the Letter of Withdrawal, I am exercising my responsibilities as Financial Delegate under Sections 32B and 32C of the *Financial Framework (Supplementary Powers) Act 2017*, and the Accountable Authority Delegations 2020 (No.2).

This Record and the attached documents are consistent with the requirements of Section 18 of the Public Governance, Performance and Accountability Rules 2014 and contain the terms of my decision. I am satisfied, after making reasonable inquiries, that giving effect to the proposal would be proper* use of Commonwealth resources and that the information in this record, including any attached documents, is accurate.

*Proper is defined in Section 8 of the *Public Governance, Performance and Accountability Act* 2013 to mean efficient, effective, economical and ethical use with relevant money.

Purpose:

To seek your agreement, as Program Owner and delegate, to issue a Letter of Withdrawal of the offer of a grant of relevant money of \$145,000 (GST exclusive) to the Eurobodalla Shire Council for the Batemans Bay CBD CCTV project.

Key Points:

- As per MS22-001643, you have delegation for all matters, including the approval of grants, terms
 and conditions of the grant, terminations, and all variations for the grants under the CDG Program.
 An email from the Department of the Prime Minister and Cabinet on 13 January 2023 confirmed
 there is no formal requirement for the Minister to advise the Prime Minister of CDG project
 withdrawals.
- Official correspondence on 14 August 2019 from the then Deputy Prime Minister, the Hon Michael McCormack MP and Member for Riverina, to the grantee, Eurobodalla Shire Council, confirms the \$145,000 commitment towards 2019 election commitment for the Batemans Bay CBD CCTV project.
- 3. On 13 December 2020, the Department received submission of a Request for Information from the Eurobodalla Shire Council for the Batemans Bay CBD CCTV project.
- 4. On 16 March 2022 an email (<u>Attachment C</u>) was received from the Eurobodalla Shire Council confirming that it is unable to deliver the funding commitment and this was confirmed in a phone conversation of 31 October 2022 (<u>Attachment B</u>).
- 5. If you approve the withdrawal of grant funding to the Eurobodalla Shire Council, a Letter of Withdrawal is at Attachment A for your signature.

Financial Impacts:

The funding will be returned to consolidated revenue.

Stakeholder Implications:

- The grantee advised the Department it can no longer deliver the project in accordance with original commitment. Therefore, there are no stakeholder implications.
- Following your approval, as per MS22-001643 program updates will be provided to the office of The Hon Catherine King MP, Minister for Infrastructure, Transport, Regional Development and Local Government to ensure overall visibility to the project.

This lighting upgrade is designed to increase night-time safety and create a place that is attractive to families and visitors, particularly in the evenings.

3. Has there been a reduction in crime in the location noted in the announcement?

Council has received correspondence from the Batemans Bay Crime Prevention Team at NSW Police regarding crime statistics for the area noted in the announcement.

NSW Police have advised that since lighting has been installed by Council in this area, there has been a decline in the categories of street and drug offences, a slight increase in property theft and the numbers have remained the same for assaults and injury/fatal crashes.

It should be noted that for Batemans Bay as a whole, street offences and injury/fatal crashes remain the same, assaults and drug offences show minor increases and there is a reduction in

- 1. Yes the outcomes of the project are in line with the initial RFI. This project will see the delivery of CCTV to the Batemans Bay regional arts, aquatic and leisure centre, known as the Bay Pavilions. This will be the hub and focal point of Batemans Bay and will be operating 24 hours a day, and the security upgrade is fully supported by the police local area command.
- 2. We do not have a quote of the specific CCTV component of security, as the CCTV is being installed by the security specialist contractor who is also installing further security throughout the site. If required, we can see a breakdown of costs of only the CCTV component, which I expect will far exceed the grant allocation as we have gone above and beyond to provide visual security systems throughout.
- 3. The funding partner contribution is a financial contribution to the project.
- 4. The project management expenditure is made up from two sources: Public Works Australia are managing the contract and implementation on behalf of Council, and ADCO constructions are project managing the design, installation, commissioning and training of systems. The project management costs are directed through those contracts.
