
#### PROBLEM DESCRIPTION

Another one of our projects is focused squarely on encouraging public transport use by upgrading to commuter car parks. We are investing in 'park and ride' facilities in \$ 22 \$ 22 Hampton, \$ 22 \$ . Many people would like to use trains but do not live within walking distance of a station. So by investing in these commuter car parks we are, literally, better connecting many people while reducing congestion for us all.

We've worked hard to select projects which provide the greatest benefit: The biggest bang for the taxpayers buck, if you like. We used an evidence-based process to target high-priority growth areas and corridors, to support broader urban development, to prioritise links to economically critically destinations – such as ports and employment centres – and to use technology such as Intelligent Transport Systems where possible.

We are tackling trouble spots to allow people to get home sooner and safer through the Urban Congestion Fund. Better roads get us all home faster. They make it easier to commute and to deliver freight, making our cities more liveable.

We look forward to working closely with the Victorian Government to deliver on these commitments this year.

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This week the **Hon Scott Morrison**, Prime Minister, alongside the **Hon Alan Tudge MP**, Minister for Cities, Urban Infrastructure, and Population, announced a total commitment of \$261.3 million towards nine new 'congestion busting' infrastructure projects in Melbourne. The projects form part of the Australian Government's \$1 billion Urban Congestion Fund (UCF). The works announced will target congestion on the \$22

The Prime Minister and Minister Tudge also announced commuter car park upgrades at six locations - s 22 , Hampton and s 22 . In addition to addressing congestion, these works are expected to improve safety and network efficiency in urban areas and support public transport usage. As the Prime Minister commented, the additional car parking and removing pinch points and bottlenecks will make a real difference to the lives of people living across Melbourne.
