THE EVENT

Recognised as the largest Indigenous sporting and cultural event in Australia and one of the largest Rugby League carnivals globally, the Koori Knockout brings together communities and teams from across NSW.

The 52nd edition of the event is expected to see participation of over 150 teams across men's, women's and youth (boys & girls) competitions.

The Koori Knockout is one of very few opportunities to witness professional sportspeople participate in a community event, with NRL men's and women's players well represented.

Hosted by the winners of the previous year's carnival, the 2024 Koori Knockout will be hosted by WAC.

HISTORY

Founded in 1971, the Koori Knockout has grown from 7 men's teams in its first year to 149 teams in 2023 participating for the most coveted titles in Indigenous sport.

The event is not only known for quality Rugby League, but is recognised as a modern day corroboree where mobs from across the country come to be part of this time honoured event.

Walgett is a foundation club, having competed in every Koori Knockout since its inception 1971. This proud history includes winning and hosting the Koori Knockout, having won the event 7 times, including 3 of the past 13 Knockouts.

This history extends back to the beginning of the Knockout which was founded by three foundation members of our club.


