I strongly object to the proposed route of the inland rail coming through suburban communities on the southern outskirts of Brisbane.

My suburb is Algester. I have lived and worked in this quiet, family orientated community for over 30 years. Extremely long trains passing through the suburb..and numerous others nearby...24 hrs a day will be so disruptive and detrimental on some many levels. Schools, playing fields, parks, aged care facilities and residential housing are very close....just metres in some cases...from the proposed track.

Then there is the issue of congestion around the Acacia Ridge terminal...it is over 30 kms from the port of Brisbane.

The main road near the rail yard is a main arterial road to Brisbane and is already heavily congested. The suburban growth south of Acacia Ridge is massive and will continue to increase over the years ahead.
