EV	EV (Electric only)
FCEV	FCEV (Fuel cell electric)
HEV – Petrol	HEV – Petrol (Non plug-in hybrid with petrol internal combustion engine)
HEV – Diesel	HEV – Diesel (Non plug-in hybrid with diesel internal combustion engine)
HEV – H2	HEV – H2 (Non plug in-hybrid with hydrogen internal combustion engine)
ICE – Petrol	ICE – Petrol (Petrol internal combustion engine)
ICE – Diesel	ICE – Diesel (Diesel internal combustion engine
ICE – CNG	ICE – CNG (CNG internal combustion engine)
ICE – LPG	ICE – LPG (LPG internal combustion engine)
ICE – Petrol + LPG	ICE – Petrol + LPG (Petrol and LPG internal combustion engine)
ICE – H2	ICE – H2 (Hydrogen internal combustion engine)
PHEV – Petrol	PHEV – Petrol (Plug-in hybrid with petrol internal combustion engine)
