



Dear Minister Rowland,

I am writing in relation to the Department of Social Services' National Consumer Protection Framework for online wagering and the requirement for online wagering services to implement the Consistent Gambling Messaging measures within 6 months, as per the Consistent Gambling Messaging implementation plan.

The National Rugby League (NRL) supports the responsible gambling messaging, and we work closely with our wagering partner to ensure we remained aligned to this. For instance, we do not permit our wagering partner to have any 'above the line' presence at our NRL major events, such as State of Origin and Grand Final. Additionally, each year we collaborate with our waging partner to produce a responsible gambling digital campaign that is NRL focused and suitable for dissemination across both NRL and our wagering partners' channels.

We were sent a copy of the reforms detailed in the implementation plan last week. It is disappointing that there was no consultation with sports about the reforms, given they could have a substantial impact on our business. Given our intimate understanding of NRL fans and those that choose to bet on rugby league we could also provide useful insights as to how best to engage fans on this important issue.

It is important for us to understand the detail of the proposed reforms, how they could be improved to better engage rugby league fans and the potential impacts on our business. This will take some time. As such, we respectfully request a pause to implementation to allow for the Department of Social Services to carry out a detailed consultation with impacted industry bodies.
