The Australian Government is introducing the New Vehicle Efficiency Standard

Starting in 2025, Australians will have increased choice of new fuel efficient cars with low or no emissions that are better for the environment.

People who buy a new fuel efficient car can expect to save money at the petrol pump every day. With the Standard, Australia will benefit from around \$95 billion in fuel savings by 2050.

The quality of the air we breathe will improve and Australians will benefit from around \$5 billion in health cost savings by 2050.
