Australia Postal Service Modernisation

Thank you for the opportunity to provide feedback for the Postal Service Modernisation.

Kyburz have contributed the largest contingent of vehicles to Australia Post's electric vehicle (EV) fleet. Our vehicles have been deployed by Australia Post across the nation from Mt Isa in far north Queensland, to Bunbury in WA and across all capital cities and major centres. Our DXP vehicles, have helped Australia Post achieve significant safety and environmental benefits. Globally, there are now over 25,000 Kyburz vehicles deployed across Europe, Asia, and Australia in the logistics industry (specifically the Last Mile) and personal mobility industry.

With the review into Australia Post, we stand ready to strengthen our relationship to help deliver more benefits on their 2025 Sustainability Roadmap journey. Initially deployed in 2017, Kyburz have now delivered over 3,600 vehicles to Australia Post and have helped reduce their serious motorcycle incident claims since deployment in 2017. This has helped Australia Post reduce their delivery rounds from 76 percent delivered by Motorcycle to 45 percent of all rounds¹. Our vehicles have also delivered economic benefits to Australia Post by increasing carrying capacity for the postie.

In addition to the significant contribution to Australia Post's EV fleet, our MultiLife strategy ensures after-market and recycling capabilities are considered. Through the support of the National Electric Vehicle Council, our initiatives are helping shape the future of the Australian Electric Vehicle roadmap. We have also submitted our proposals for environmentally friendly battery recycling capabilities to the National Battery Strategy, supporting the Federal Government's commitment to the electrification of Australia.

We look forward to the next steps and continue to work closely on their future.
