**Topic:** Practical Driving Tests and Pre-Learner Road Ready Course

## Practical Driving Assessments (P-Plate) – 15 and 16 April 2025

Learner drivers eligible to upgrade from a Learner 'L' Plate to Provisional 'P' Plate licence can take a practical driving assessment on **Tuesday 15th or Wednesday 16th April 2025**.

The driving assessment is a practical on-road test that focuses on your ability to perceive hazards and respond to them. A Testing Officer assesses your driving skills, decision-making, your awareness of other road users and how you share the road.

To make a booking for a driving test, you need to:

- Pay the applicable fee of \$124.30
- Be at least 17 years of age
- Have held a Learner Driver licence for 12 months, or 6 months if aged 25 years or over
- Provide a roadworthy vehicle for the driving test (a vehicle is not supplied)
- Provide a completed Logbook with a record of the minimum driving hours required:
  - Under 25 – minimum of 90 Day hours and 10 Night hours
  - 25 years over – minimum 45 Day hours and 5 Night hours.

**Please note:** If the required driving hours are not completed in the Logbook, a driving test cannot be conducted.

## Pre-Learner Licence Road Ready Course – 17 April 2025

JBT residents eligible to obtain their Learner Driver licence can complete the Pre-Learner Licence Course on **Thursday 17th April 2025**. The course will be held from 10am-3pm at the Jervis Bay Territory Office located at 50 Village Road, Jervis Bay.

The Road Ready Course is a Pre-Learner licence course which introduces new drivers to key concepts before obtaining a Learner Licence and undergoing practical driving lessons.

To enrol in the course, participants need to:

- Pay the applicable fee of \$210.00 - if the applicant is not enrolled in school
- The course is free for students currently enrolled in school. Proof of school enrolment must be supplied
- Be at least 15 years and 9 months of age
- Provide full proof of identity - 100 points
- Provide proof of residency in the JBT.
