- 3 Speed matters as it limits the number of devices that can be used. Radio reception here is below standard so streaming is necessary. There is at least one drop out per hour.
- 4 There is fibre to the corner and copper from that to the house.
- 5 This service is unsatisfactory for current usage let alone any projected future use.
