The lack of Internet and mobile phone coverage is appalling. Having to walk outside, even walk up the paddock or out to the front gate trying to get coverage is frustrating. If we're inside and lucky enough to get a phone call on our mobile, and it actually rings, we can't talk on it and walk to another area of the house, most times it drops out. No internet in our bedroom at all..

My husband lost his home out here in Black Saturday, he did rebuild, but with poor Mobile internet coverage, the Emergency App is useless.

We are surrounded on 2 fencelines by HVP Pines, which may play a part in poor service.
