These warnings required all ground crew to be removed from outdoor locations, pausing all operations. This delayed all flights departing Adelaide Airport. A dispensation was granted for landing at Sydney Airport no later than 23:30 local time. QF748 had 137 passengers and 6 crew on-board, with 2 shipments of Saving Human Lives goods. The aircraft arrived at 23:11 local time.
