- I, James Woodman believe that online content scheme under Part 9 of the Bill should be removed as it is not related to issues of online safety and is likely to harm the livelihood of sex workers, adult media performers and adults-only businesses. These businesses are an important part of our Australian identity of freedom and self-expression.
- -The role of the eSafety Commissioner should be to focus on non-consensual, abusive and harmful content and not imagery of consensual sexual activity between adults. Using the eSafety Commission as a tool of censorship and moral judgement would be a waste of the resources of the commission. There is infinite more gain to be made to the good of our culture ensuring consent and safety in online content than there is in performing judgement.
