I have never been one who is good with formality so I shall keep this brief

The online content scheme under Part 9 of the Bill should be removed as it is not related to issues of online safety. Instead the only function of this part is the harm to consenting adults who participate in sex work and/ or the creation of adult content. Including educational content- which will ultimately cause more harm than good. Sex and kink education should be easily accessible as people will do what they want, but having the information available can be the difference between a fun time between consenting adults, and someone ending up traumatised or even killed.

The role of the eSafety Commissioner should be to focus on non-consensual, abusive and harmful content and not imagery of consensual sexual activity between adults.
