

Dear Australian Government,

I want to state my opinion about the proposed "Online Safety Act" legislation part 9 section, which financially punishing social media platforms and search engine providers who do not remove certain adult related content within a 24-hour deadline:

1. The online content scheme under Part 9 of the Bill should be removed as it is not related to issues of online safety and is likely to harm the livelihood of sex workers, adult media performers and adults-only businesses.

2. The role of the eSafety Commissioner should be to focus on non-consensual, abusive and harmful content and not imagery of consensual sexual activity between adults.

Please reconsider the part 9 section to protect the personal freedoms of Australians.
