I have been watching with interest on what has been happening, and feel more trepidation and worry than anything. Our TV shows have been cut down too much in the last few years, when really they need to be increased.

Dr Scott said "We're losing Australian culture. No one else can tell Australian stories like Australia," and he is correct 100%. Why are we allowing this to happen?

I mean look at All Saints, Packed To The Rafters, Love Child and Blue Heelers for example. Why were these axed when they had the highest number of viewers? Why? Why did the government feel justified not to keep giving funding for these shows?

In my opinion, those shows delivered not only fictional stories, but also true stories of Australian life. They were the lifeblood of our TV and our Australian voices.

The funding needs to be increased for television shows, not decreased just to keep mining in business for the very few elite who do not really live in our country. Last but not least, please start making a new legislation to give compulsory Closed Captions to ALL TV shows across every station including sub channel stations to bring equal access into our TV industry. As it is, our Australian Deaf community have been screaming really loudly of late for this. 7Flix for example often fails to CC everything. America has done the right thing and given the Deaf community compulsory equal access. Australia needs to do the same.
