# **CIRCULAR NO 34A-2-1**

---

## **ADR 34A CHILD RESTRAINT ANCHORAGES - UPPER ANCHOR FITTING**

### **INTRODUCTION**

1. ADR 34A Clause 34A.2.4 (b) and (c) requires manufacturers to specify in the vehicle handbook, or otherwise supply with the vehicle, the thickness of spacers and length of bolt required at each upper anchorage location.
2. At the date of issue of this Circular Australian Standard AS 1754-1975 Child Restraints, which is a mandatory Australian Standard for child restraints, had not been amended to include the standard anchor fittings specified in ADR 34A.

### **INFORMATION REQUIRED**

3. Accordingly the Board has agreed that it will not be necessary for manufacturers to provide the information required under Clauses 34A.2.4 (b) and (c) until further notice.
